#### **Practices Shared**

#### Rochester School 17:

- Implementation ~4 years, use the IEL logic model to help guide
  - Lead agency is Coordinated Care Services, Inc. and contracted for 12 months, help facilitate team meetings
  - Focused on asset-based community development process, multi-system engagement & partnership evaluation.

#### • Foci:

- Neighborhood school: seamless enrollment, increased to 77%
- Attendance: increase daily attendance to 90%, chronic absenteeism reduced # days from average of 36 to 24
- Service learning: Project- Based Learning (PBL) based, hold quarterly expositions
- Family engagement: PTO, serv safe classes & development of community kitchen, able to self-cater school events
- Persistently violent: drastic reduction in # of incidents, implementing responsive classroom, Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS)





# New developments:

Strategic plan: work collaboratively with Monroe County,
 United Way & CCI to use design process for human- centered planning

# Student Communications Multi-tiered Tracking Tool:

- Shared google sheet that teachers, related service and internal SEL & behavioral health providers use
- Monitors student progress in classrooms/assignments, also provides communication updates and links to classroom resources
- Tier I: All students assigned 1:1 to staff member, teachers enter data/communications by Monday/Tuesday
- Tier II teams: meet mid-week, check template and follow up with families that need assistance, resources, or did not check in to academics that week (members include internal SEL & attendance partners)
- Tier III: referrals made to necessary contacts via Qawan-external providers do not have access to shared document. Careful to match with trusted contact (use established relationships) and not inundate families with multiple calls/outreach.
  - Case management tracking form used: entries go directly to site coordinator (Qawan) who then refers to needed services. Staff can check form for updates on the referral process to progress monitor.
- Document creation: utilized Data Validation & conditional formatting to create drop down boxes within template
- Internal partners: SEL, attendance partners included in annual consent sent out to families, agencies sign NDA yearly





## Considerations

- Warm hand off: established, trusted relationships can be key.
   Utilizing staff/providers that have relationships with families to introduce them to new services/personnel
- Attendance Champions: assigned to grade level, responsible for reaching out to families which assists teachers with communications and ensuring all families contacted; big support to instructional staff
- Staff relationships: empathetic listening and using the collective work of community schools to lift staff as well as families and students.
